All citizens are advised that the Beaver Island Transportation Authority has prepared an application for State of Michigan financial assistance for Fiscal Year 2021, as required under Act 51 of the public Acts of 1951, as amended.

The Beaver Island Transportation Authority is requesting \$177,822.00 from the State of Michigan Marine Capital Passenger assistance, (engine rebuilds), operating assistance in the total amount of \$648,790. Local match amounts are included in both requests. \$85,000 from the State of Michigan Service Development and New Technology Program to update the agency's master plan.

The proposed application is on file at the Beaver Island Transportation Authority, 26195 Main Street, Beaver Island, Michigan, and may be reviewed during a 30 day period beginning February 18, 2020, between the hours of 10:00 am and 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday or at beaverislandtransportationauthority.com.
